



## **Freman College Ski trip 2026 – Folgarida/Marilleva, Italy**

The trip will take place during Easter holidays 2026, departing on the Saturday 28th March and returning on Saturday 4th April. Places are decided via a ballot rather than on a first-come, first-served basis. The cost of the trip is £1375 and there is no financial assistance available. All places are subject to approval by the Heads of House and the Headteacher. This is a very physically demanding trip with students skiing 5 hours a day and they will need to have a good level of fitness to cope with it. Any student who has taken a term time holiday will not be allowed on the trip. Approval will be based on good conduct in lessons and around the college. There are 90 places available. We are travelling at Easter due to the Olympics happening in Northern Italy over half term and this has dramatically increased costs and reduced the number of beds available at half term.

# About the resort

Folgarida-Marilleva in the Trentino-Alto Adige region of Italy, is a large resort with 27 lifts (7 gondolas, 15 chair lifts, 5 surface lifts) that offers skiers an impressive 880 metres (2887 feet) of vertical descent. Folgarida has 28 pistes with a total length of 50 kilometers (31 miles). Folgarida is best suited to beginner skiers and snowboarders but there is some terrain for both expert and intermediates. There are 47 kilometers (29 miles) of cross-country ski trails at Folgarida. For snowboarders, there is a terrain park and a half-pipe. Most of the pistes at Folgarida are covered by snowmaking. Folgarida is connected to Marilleva (Folgarida-Marilleva) and Madonna di Campiglio, providing a total of 120 kms between the Brenta Dolomites and the Ortles Cevedale group.

## Hotel Marilleva 1400

The Hotel is situated at the bottom of the slopes. The rooms within the hotel are all modern, recently refurbished and all with ensuite facilities. The hotel has doorstep skiing.
