3G ALL WEATHER PITCH CODE OF CONDUCT

Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct is for the benefit of all site users, students and staff, teams, football spectators and residents.

- Aggressive and violent behaviour towards students, staff, officials, residents or players will not be tolerated.
- Swearing or foul language and anti-social behaviour on or off the pitch is unacceptable. The operator reserves the right to dismiss users from the pitch and may lead to the cancellation of pitch hire agreements. Any decision taken by the college in this respect will be final.
- All pitch users should behave in a responsible and considerate manner so that disturbance to local residents is kept to an absolute minimum.
- Smoking or the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted in any area of the college site including the 3G All Weather Pitch and surrounds or changing facilities. Any hirer, or member of their organisation, (including opposition teams if match play is taking place and spectators) found smoking will be suspended from using these facilities.
- Hirers, coaches, officials, players and supporters must not bring or consume alcohol or drugs on any point of the site, building or grounds.
- Football boots of any kind i.e. studs, blades, must be removed at all times before entering the college buildings, excluding the outdoor changing rooms and toilets.
- Abuse of the facilities will not be tolerated and will result in the hirer being suspended from use of the 3G All Weather Football Pitch.
- Any damage caused to facilities will be charged to the hirer and/or organisation responsible.
- Hirers, coaches, players and supporters will be expected to dispose of their litter responsibly. Any litter found on and around the 3G All Weather Football Pitch is the responsibility of the hirer to remove at the end of their session. A charge will be made should they fail to do so.
- Any regulated activity which involves working directly with children and young people under the age of 18 - such as managers and coaches and volunteers - must be aware of the safeguarding policy and procedure. Staff and volunteers must also undertake safeguarding training appropriate to their role and level of responsibility. The organisation is also responsible for ensuring that appropriate disclosure and barring service checks are carried out for staff and volunteers.
- All hirers must ensure suitable levels of supervision for children and young people at the CPSU recommended minimum ratios
- Hirers should park in the designated college car parking areas for community use. Consideration must be given to residents when parking vehicles outside of these areas.
- Failure to observe these Code of Conduct guidelines may result in enforcement action being undertaken and bookings being cancelled.

APPENDIX 3

3G ALL WEATHER PITCH FOOTWEAR RULES

Keeping the facility in top condition and maintaining the pitch's surface is a top priority for the college and community. We need to keep the surface to the highest possible standard to ensure its longevity.

It is therefore critical that all **players, staff, officials, coaches** and **whoever plays or has access** on the pitch wears the correct footwear.

PITCH RULES

To avoid damaging the surface only the permitted footwear may be worn on the pitch.

Boots **MUST NOT** be muddy

Warm up must not take place within the goal mouth

No smoking, naked flames or vaping

No chewing gum

No food on the pitch

Sports water bottle with **water** only

No pets

No vehicles, cycles, scooters, roller skates etc.
